Pro-Am and Am-Am Medal Test Levels and What Successful Candidates Receive

- 1. Newcomer (2 dances) minimum** Styles may be mixed in this category only A minimum of 2 Basic figures per dance Receive an evaluation and a certificate
- 2. Beginners (2 dances) minimum** the first half of the syllabus Receive an evaluation and a certificate
- 3. Intermediate Bronze (Pre-Bronze) (3 dances)** The first half of the syllabus Receive an evaluation and a certificate **3. Full Bronze (2 dances)** The full Bronze syllabus Receive an evaluation, a certificate,
- 4. Intermediate Silver (3 dances)** The first half of the Silver syllabus Receive an evaluation and certificate
- 5. Full Silver (3 dances)** The full Silver syllabus Receive an evaluation, a certificate,
- 6. Intermediate Gold (all dances)** The first half of the Gold syllabus Receive an evaluation and a certificate
- 7. Full Gold (all dances)** The full Gold syllabus Receive an evaluation, a certificate,
- 8. Gold Star I (4 dances in Smooth or Ballroom, 5 dances in Rhythm or Latin)** 16 bars of Syllabus required then continue with open material, Receive an evaluation, a certificate,
- 9. Gold Star II** Open with Receive an evaluation, a certificate, and an engraved, Lucite star Continuation of Pro/Am and Am/Am Medal Test and Levels.
- 10. One Dance Medal Test (1 dance)** Any style at Bronze, Silver, or Gold level Receive an evaluation and a certificate
- 11. Theatrical Dance and Formation** Receive an evaluation and a certificate

Professional Degrees dance requirements

Pro- International Style Ballroom

(4 dances required);

Waltz, Tango, Foxtrot and Quickstep.

Pro-International Style Latin-American

(5 dances required)

Cha-Cha, Samba, Rumba, Paso Doble and Jive

Pro- American Style Smooth:

(4 dances required);

Waltz, Tango, Foxtrot and Viennese Waltz.

Pro-American Style Rhythm;

(5 dances required)

Cha-Cha, Rumba, Swing, Bolero and Mambo.

Pro- Theatrical Dance Syllabus

(Associated Members and Fellows)

In each of these styles above you can earn a degrees, in the Associate, Members, Fellowship

All Pro-Test cost \$95 per test paid to NADTA and annual Dues of \$85, plus Examiner hourly fees travel expenses are paid directly to the Examiner. Most popular now is the use of Zoom Testing. Saving the aspiring candidate travel expenses.

Theatrical Dancing Syllabus

The Degree's available are Associate, Members and Fellows, the requirement and the designated duration of time it takes to administer each Test

1. Associate degree:(all the Bronze) Available in all styles.

Dance as Man and as Lady. Plus, the Theory portion in any of the figures used in the Bronze Syllabus

Examination length: **2 hours** for the Ballroom and the Smooth

and **2 hours and 15 minutes** Latin and Rhythm

2. Member Degree:(all the Bronze and the Silver) Available in all styles.

Dance as Man and as Lady. Plus, the Theory portion in any of the Bronze and the Silver Syllabus.

Examination length: **2.5 hours** Ballroom and Smooth and **2 hours and 45 minutes** Latin and Rhythm

3. Fellow Degree:

(All the Bronze Silver and Gold)

Available in all styles.

Dance as Man and as Lady. Plus, the Theory in any of Bronze, Silver and Gold .

Examination length: **2.5 hours** Ballroom and Smooth and **2 hours and 45 minutes** Latin and Rhythm

4. Theatrical Dancing Syllabus associate's degree: Bronze

Dance Solo routine with partner

plus, a written Test then the Theory portion Examination length: **2 hour** exam.

5. Theatrical Dancing Syllabus Member Degree:

(All the Bronze and the Silver) Dance Solo routine with partner plus a written Test, then then the Theory portion.

Examination length: **2.5-hour** exam.
