The first half of the syllabus
Receive an evaluation and a certificate

3. Intermediate Bronze (Pre-Bronze) (3 dances)

The first half of the syllabus
Receive an evaluation and a certificate

3. Full Bronze (2 dances)

The full Bronze syllabus
Receive an evaluation, a certificate,

4. Intermediate Silver (3 dances)

The first half of the Silver syllabus
Receive an evaluation and a certificate

5. Full Silver (3 dances)

The full Silver syllabus

6. Intermediate Gold (all dances)
